Rainer E. Burkard



Rainer E. Burkard is Professor of Mathematics at the University of Technology in Graz, Austria. He obtained his PhD in Mathematics at the University of Vienna in 1967. From 1973-81 he was Professor of Applied Mathematics at the University of Cologne, Germany, 1979-1981 he had a joint appointment with the Technical University of Aachen (Germany). His research interests lie in Discrete Optimisation, being the author of the first German book on Integer Programming (1972), co-author of a book on Assignment and Matching Problems (1981) and author of over 140 papers dealing mainly with structural and algorithmic aspects of combinatorial optimisation and its applications. Moreover, he is author of a computer course (teachware) on graph algorithms and co-editor of several collected works in Operations Research, Applied Mathematics and Computer Science. He received the Award of the Austrian Mathematical Society in 1971, the Scientific Prize of the Society of Mathematics, Economics and Operations Research in 1991 and the EURO Gold Medal 1997. He served as Vice-President of GMÖOR from 1984-86, as President of the Austrian Operations Research Society from 1986-88, as EURO Vice-president of IFORS from 1995-97 and as

Dean of the Faculty of Science, Graz University of Technology, 1993-96. He was member of the Council of the European Consortium of Mathematics in Industry (1994-1998) and has been a member of the Senate of the Christian Doppler Research Society (1991-2000). 1998 he was elected as an Honorary Member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences.

He is editor of *Zeitschrift für Operations Research* (editor in chief from 1984-89), and member of the editorial board of *Annals of Operations Research*, of *Discrete Applied Mathematics*, of *European Journal of Operations Research*, of the *Belgian Journal of Operations Research, Statistics and Computer Science*, of *Optimisation*, of *Yugoslav Journal of Operations Research*, of *Central European Journal of Operations Research*, of *RAIRO Recherche Opérationnelle*, of *Computing*, of the *Journal of Universal Computer Science*, of the *Journal of Computing and Information Technology*, of the *Chinese Transactions in Operations Research* and of the *Journal of Combinatorial Optimisation*. He is Principal Editor of *Mathematics in Industrial Systems* and editor of the *SIAM Monographs on Discrete Mathematics and Applications*.



### Marino Widmer



Marino Widmer was born on 12 March 1960 and is Swiss citizen. He studied at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne (EPFL). In 1985 he became mathematics engineer and in 1990 he completed a PhD in technical sciences (applied mathematics). Finally, he obtained an "habilitation" in information management in 1998 at the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences of the University of Fribourg (Switzerland).

From 1985 to 1991 he was first assistant and afterwards scientific fellow in Operational Research at the EPFL (with Professor Dominique de Werra). In 1991 he was appointed at the University of Fribourg as associate professor in Production Management and CIM (Computer Integrated Manufacturing). Since the first February 2002, he is full professor in information management at the University of Fribourg.

His research activity is mainly focused on the application of operational research to industrial problems (layout, planning, scheduling, human resource management, supply chain management). He is author or co-author of number of publications in renowned journals and was guest editor of three special issues of Discrete Applied Mathematics.

Additionally he acts as referee for international journals (over 60 papers) and was member of over thirteen PhD commissions. He is expert for international research projects (Canada, Italy, France and Switzerland) and participated till now in the organisation of many international conferences. He realises also industrial projects for companies.

He is member of the Swiss (ASRO), the Italian (AIRO) and the American OR societies (INFORMS). Since 1997 he is in charge of the bulletin of the Swiss OR Society.



A new EURO web site has been build. This site is available since December 2001. The main topics of the previous one have been kept and several new features introduced. The objective is to enhance contact and exchange of information in the EURO community.

- Only registered users have access to the archive.
- Files are limited to 2 Mb.

# First Circular and Call for Papers 14th Mini EURO Conference **Human Centered Processes HCP'2003** **"Distributed decision making and man-machine cooperation"** **5-7 May 2003, Luxembourg**

## Objectives

The Commission of the European Union, in its forthcoming sixth framework Programme, specifically recognizes the necessity to place human beings at the centre of future development of the knowledge-based society and more specifically the emerging e-government. In addition, a EURO working group on Human Centered Processes has recently been created in order to tackle the study of operational strategies and processes used by people in professional contexts (<http://www-hcp.enst-bretagne.fr/>). Such problems represent important challenges for both public administrations and commercial firms. More generally, the analysis and study of distributed decision making and man-machine interaction requires a multi-disciplinary approach involving cognitive psychology, operational research, cognitive science and domain expertise. Indeed, cognitive design and implementation approaches can complement more traditional frame-works. They may allow design and analysis of more complete, complex, robust and secure systems involving experienced users with specific domain expertise as well as common users.

The purpose of this conference is to bring together:

- Practitioners from industry and administration who are confronted with issues related to cognition and domain expertise and computer assisted collaborative work.
- Researchers who have expertise in Cognitive Psychology or more generally Cognitive Science, Artificial Intelligence and Computer Science.
- Operational Researchers interested in discussing human centred approaches applied to complex industrial and administrative problems.

In view of this, the Conference focuses on practical application oriented themes where human cen-

tered approaches have already shown their usefulness including planning, scheduling, decision making, quality control, project management, intelligent management of multimedia documents, e-commerce and e-government.

Also, this Mini EURO conference shares the interest of the Luxembourg National Research Fund in promoting international scientific cooperation on the topic of security and efficiency of new organizational models and new practices in electronic cooperation.

## Venue

## Call for papers

Three kinds of submissions are welcome:

- Proposal for a session (of three papers) dedicated to a given topic. After acceptance, the promoter will be responsible for his/her session and will chair it.
- Proposal for a panel discussion on a given topic (one hour). After acceptance, the promoter will be responsible for his/her session and will serve as session chair.
- Free submission of papers on the basis of a summary (one page). The accepted papers will be organized into sessions devoted to given topics.

Two types of sessions, panel discussions or papers are solicited: those discussing cognitive theories and practices from a practical application perspective and those presenting administrative, business or industrial applications. Suitable sessions, panel

discussions and papers include: distributed decision making, human expertise centred decision aids, man-machine cooperation, intelligent assistance for decision, knowledge extraction, representation and modelling, intelligent management of multi-media documents, perception, recognition and interpretation and intelligent operator guidance and assistance systems.

Application reports may cover the following: practice and integration, quality control, management of industrial and administrative processes, scheduling and planning, industrial production, supervision and control, public administration, transportation, health care, banking, insurance, telecommunications, management of the environment, new technologies for information and communication.

## **Publication**

Selected papers will be proposed for publication (and refereed separately) in a feature issue of the European Journal of Operational Research (EJOR).

A specific publication for French, Italian, Spanish or Portuguese versions of the accepted papers is also foreseen in a special issue of the IN COGNITO journal.

## **General Support Deadline for the submission of bids for the second semester of 2002**

The purpose of the "General Support funds" is to support any activity related to EURO that cannot be covered by other instruments of EURO. However, the "General Support fund" should not be used as a support to regular activities of the member societies (such as national meetings and conferences). Priority will always be given to:

- bids that give special consideration to the need of students (e.g. organiser of an event related to EURO willing to subsidise the participation of students),
- bids that give special consideration to the need of organisers of OR events in Central and Eastern Europe,
- bids that emanate from a member society of EURO or organisers of EURO sponsored events or organisers of events sponsored by a member society of EURO.

The bids are kept informal. They should however always contain a description of the project and a budget. They should mention the support that has been obtained or solicited from other sources. Although bids emanating from individuals (e.g. students willing to attend a Conference closely related to EURO) are, in principle, acceptable they will be given a very low priority. They are approved only in exceptional cases.

Organisers of events receiving General Support funds from EURO are required:

- to publicise the support of EURO in the documents of the Conference,
- to produce a report on the use of the funds no later than 3 months after the event,
- to accompany their report by all original receipts.

Bids for "EURO General Support funds" are examined twice a year on a competitive basis. For 2002 the budget allocated to this instrument is 10000 euros. We plan to spend half of this money for the second semester of 2002 (bids are not restricted to projects taking place during this period).
